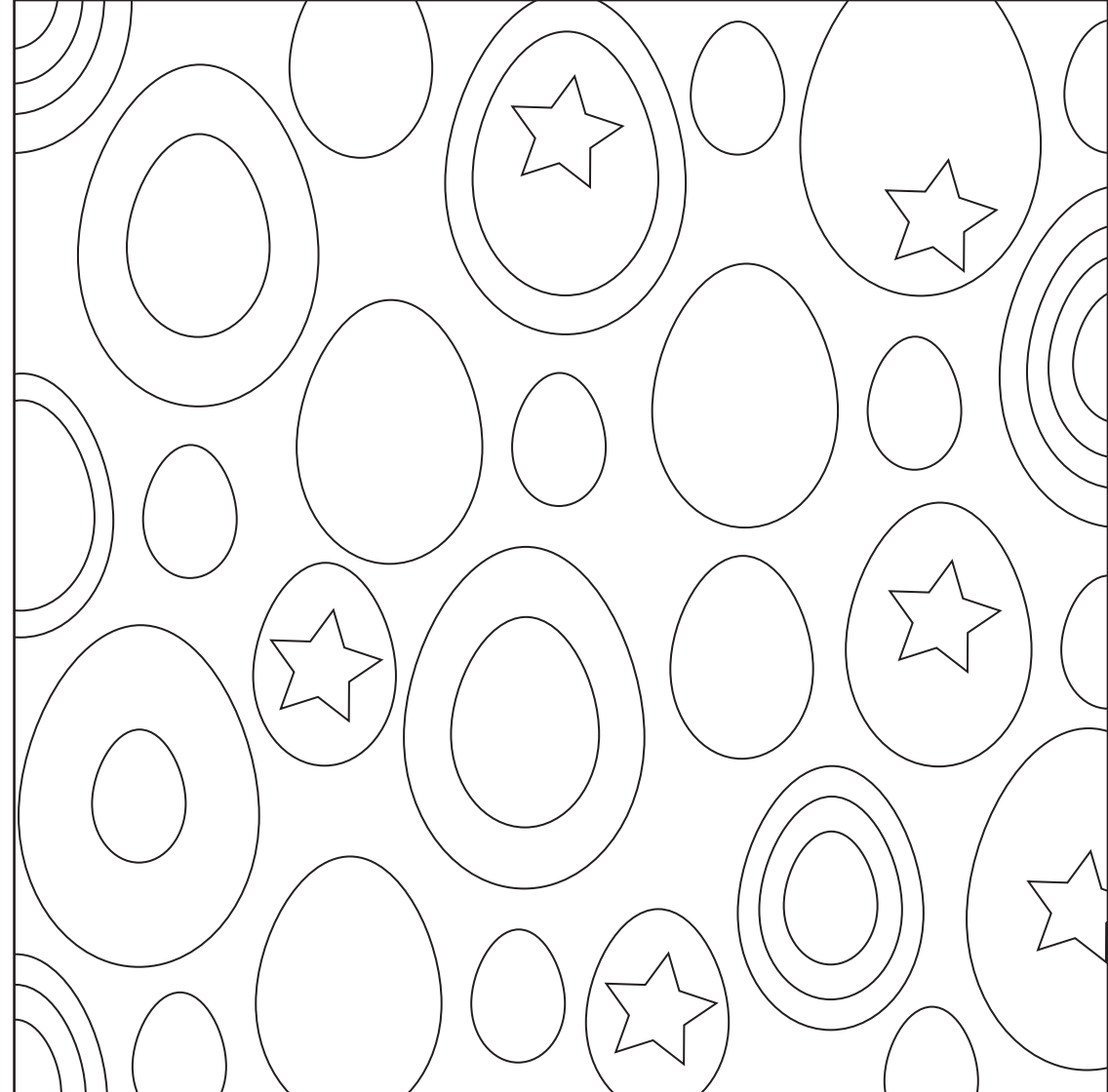
You will need:

materials

2 A4 card sheets
tissue paper
glue stick
felt pen

You will need:

scissors
scrap paper to protect the table
(optional) string



1. Use **TWO** sheets of card
Fold in half lengthways
Draw a series of outlines
the shape of half an egg - it
will look like a wonky
rainbow!

2. **Cut** along the lines and
unfold to make the egg
outlines



3. **Cut** shapes from the
tissue paper
apply the **glue** to **ONE**
of each egg outlines
and **stick** the tissue on

4. **Repeat** with more layers
/other colours until the
eggs are filled in



5. **Stick** the matching egg
outline on top



6. **Trim** the tissue paper to
create a neat outline



7. You can use blutak to
stick the eggs onto a
window
or use thread to hang
them in a group
