The main corridors have 24 hour access. Department areas inc. Medical Surgical and Endoscopy corridors are closed from 5pm and at weekends

There are refreshments at Springs Restaurant on Level 2 until 7pm and weekends.



All of the building is wheelchair accessible. Lifts to all levels are at either end and in the centre of main corridor (see exhibition plan) Wheelchairs are available from main entrance.



Hearing and guide Dogs are welcome.

There are ladies and gents toilets in main entrance and on level 4; a wheelchair accessible toilet is situated near reception, level 3 main entrance.

There are baby changing areas provided in level 3 & 4 toilet facilities.

Travelling by bus - From Salisbury City Centre

Wilts & Dorset city service "Red 1" runs regularly from the city centre to the hospital. The bus leaves from Stop O in Blue Boar Row on the north side of the market square. The journey takes around 10 minutes. Buses run in an anti clockwise direction around the hospital site stopping in the following places:

- The Green (for the Central and South parts of the hospital)
- Springs Entrance (for Level 2 of the main hospital)
- **Main Entrance (for Levels 3 and 4 of the main hospital) EXHIBITIONS**



**Railway station** Salisbury has a direct rail link with London, Exeter, the West of England, Bristol, South Wales, Southampton and Portsmouth. Pulseline bus stop (journey time to hospital about 21 minutes)



**Parking** - Car park tariffs are displayed on boards besides the Pay and Display machines or Pay on Foot machines (depending on the car park) in all public car parks at Salisbury District Hospital.
