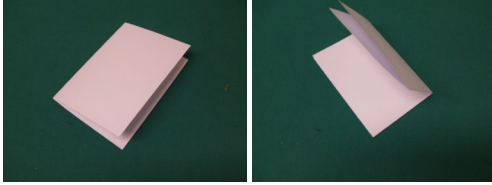
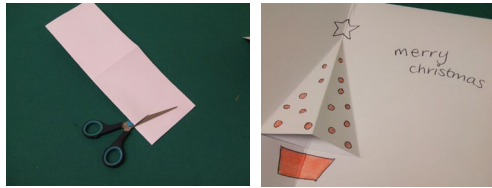


Pop-up Christmas card

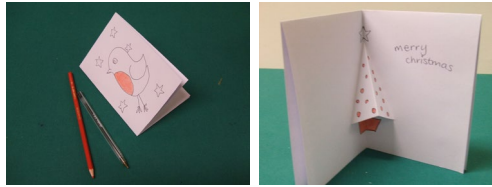
If you're going to use paint or glue, protect your working surface with newspaper or an old cloth and wear old clothes or an apron.



1. Fold a sheet of A4 card in half and then fold once more. This will be the finished card size



2. Open the card out again and re-fold it long ways. Cut a short, straight line from the fold. As you fold the card back to its finished shape, gently pull the centre forwards to make a triangle crease. Decorate this triangle to look like a pop up Christmas tree.



3. Draw a Christmassy picture on the front of the card. You have finished your card and it's ready to send!

Materials and equipment

- Sheet of card – any colour you like
- Scissors
- Pencils or pens

Other ideas & tips:

- Use old Christmas cards for inspiration
- Paint your picture on instead of drawing
- Use colour stickers like simple stars or dots to use as 'tree decorations'
- Use sequins or scrap wrapping paper or other collage materials
- Use glitter to add extra sparkle
